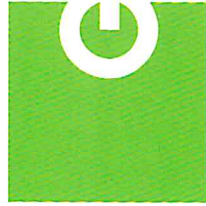

Need help budgeting or with benefits?**

We offer a flexible, mobile support service tailored to your housing needs and led by you. It is a short term intervention service to help address your housing needs and promote independent living.

If you are aged 18 or over and live in Gloucester, Tewkesbury or the Forest of Dean and need help to avoid homelessness and achieve independence, then our service is for you.

There is no restriction on tenure or timescales. If ongoing support is required, we will complete a support plan with you and review it on a regular basis. We can also help you with one off issues to help you stay in your home.

We can help you to:

- Set up home for the first time
- Maintain your current accommodation
- Explore alternatives if you need to move
- Connect with networks and activities in your local community

- Access education, training and work
- Deal with personal admin
- Budget and pay bills
- Claim welfare benefits
- Advocate on your behalf
- Gain confidence to do these things for yourself

We can do this by:

- Crisis intervention within 24 hours
- Regular one to one support in your home
- Help desk with advice line
- Community social groups
- Resettlement advice
- Community drop-ins
- Life skills workshops
