### **Parking – A Neighbours Plea! – NB the details of the cars identified have been sent to the police**

*'I am writing to complain about the parking situation around Churchdown Village Infants School.*

*Every weekday morning is the same - parents parking their cars on The Piece (astonishingly this happens directly in front of and underneath signs that say "private road, no parking"), right next to the turning onto The Piece, which is notorious enough to navigate due to the bumpy surface and tight turn before the issue of parked cars arises. It should be noted that the "private road" signs carry a clamping warning as well.*

*More so, I am a resident at Sandfield Court (directly opposite the school and between The Piece and The Avenue) and yet certain parents feels that our private driveway, used by the residents of this building, is a suitable place to park every weekday morning in order to drop their children off at school! I understand that a parking close to the school is difficult at peak times, but using a residential building's driveway is not the answer.*

*It would be greatly appreciated if the concerns of local residents could be expressed further to the parents parking near the school, as using private roads and driveways is, quite frankly, unacceptable.'*
